



# HEBREW DATE STAMPER

## Version 2.0

### **Installation:**

If Purchased Online:

1. Download Hebrew Date Stamper (HDS) to your PC
2. Double Click, "setup.exe", this will launch the installer
3. Follow the onscreen instructions to install HDS

If Purchased in a Retail Store and you have the CD

1. Insert the CD into your Windows PC
2. Click on the button: "Install"
3. Follow the onscreen instructions to install HDS

### **Operation:**

Once installed HDS will load into the windows system tray at startup. You will know HDS is installed and running if you see a small Jewish Star Icon (Blue on White) in the lower right hand corner of your screen (near the clock).

If you roll your mouse over this icon HDS will display the secular date, the Hebrew date and any related Holiday or Parsha information in a small bubble window.

### **To Paste Date Information:**

From within any document, place the cursor where you would like the date information to be pasted. Use the following key combination to paste the desired information:

Paste Hebrew Date = ctrl-win-H

Paste Secular Date = ctrl-win-E

Paste Both Hebrew and Secular Date = ctrl-win-B

The ctrl and win keys are the left most and bottom most keys on a standard keyboard, depress them down at the same time and then while depressing those keys, depress H, E, or B depending on your desired outcome.

These key combinations are also displayed in the HDS menu, accessible by right clicking the HDS Icon in the system tray.

## Date Lookup:

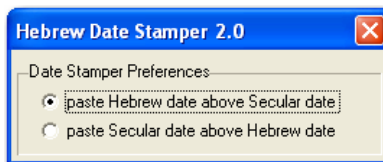
Right click the HDS Icon to access the Date Lookup Feature. The following window will appear:



Use the left or right most arrow to cycle through dates year by year, use the inner arrows to cycle month by month. Choose the secular date that you are looking for and the Hebrew date will display in the field below. Use the buttons at the bottom of the window to copy the data to your clipboard. Once the data is on your clipboard you can paste it into your document using the paste command in your application. Usually this is found in the Edit menu and often it is a keyboard shortcut of ctrl-V. HDS contain 30 years of Hebrew Date Data. Future version will contain more. Close the lookup window by clicking on the orange [X] in the right hand corner. This will not QUIT HDS, HDS will continue to run in your system tray.

## Preferences

Right click the Jewish Star Icon to access preferences. In preferences you can specify if you want the Hebrew Date to appear above or below the Secular Date when pasting both with the ctrl-win-B combination.



## Uninstalling HDS:

You can uninstall HDS by using the windows install/remove programs utility found in the Windows Control Panel.
